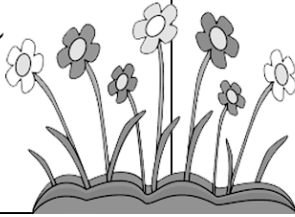

A Note from our March speaker . . . Betz Green

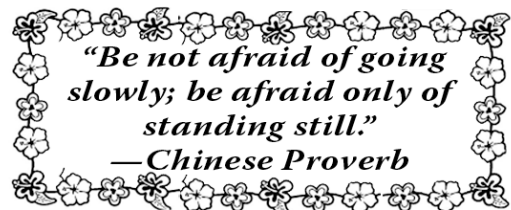
Dear Bucks Mont Art League,
